## **Scholarship Program Guidelines**

The William Sherman Winseman Foundation (W.S.W. Foundation) is dedicated to helping youth in targeted communities to attend to and succeed in the educational arena. The belief that, "Every child can and will learn with the proper educational resources," is echoed throughout the Foundation's work.

*One of our Missions* is dedicated to assist children, the elderly, and the disabled, for purpose of awareness, needs and educational opportunities. The purpose of the Foundation also includes: Education, Enlightenment, and Inspiration. We learn in a number of ways through reading, instruction, performing, and practical application. The Foundation works in numerous ways to promote educational values.

*Our Vision* is to empower youth in a designated area with need-based educational resources.

*Our Purpose* is to provide scholarships, as well as honorariums – starter funds for deserving students intending to pursue a course of study at either a two-year (2) or four-year (4) educational institution.

#### Criteria and eligibility

- 1. Applicant Fee: \$15.00 Fifteen Dollars.
- 2. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 3. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 grade point average (a "B or above" average, including a Certified Copy of transcript.)
- 4. Applicant must demonstrate community involvement, improvement in academics, and desire to attend college.
- 5. Applicant should have completed at least 80+ hours of community service. Community service hours must be documented in the form of a letter of recommendation on the letter head of organization.
- 6. Applicants are required to pay \$40 fee if they do not have community service hours as recommended.
- 7. Applicants will have to view three streaming programs on The Film Festival Channel and answer a quick questionnaire regarding the programs educational value.
- 8. A Photograph (Self Portrait)

### Criteria and eligibility (returning recipients)

- 1. Applicant Fee: \$15.00 Fifteen Dollars.
- 2. Applicant must be a recipient of the WSWF Scholarship Fund Program.
- 3. Applicant must be currently enrolled in a two-year (2) to four-year (4) educational institution.
- 4. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 grade point average (a "B or above" average, including <u>Certified Copy</u> of transcript required.)
- 5. Applicant should have completed at least 80+ hours of community service. Community service hours must be documented in the form of a letter of recommendation on the letter head of organization.
- 6. A Photograph (Self Portrait)

#### General Instructions

- 1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications vary depending on the scholarship program (no exceptions).
- 2. Refer to application process below for a list of supporting documents needed (i.e. reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. If any question does not apply to you in this application, please put N/A in the space.
- 4. Type and print legibly (illegible applications will not be considered). You may also download a copy of the application online at www.wsw-foundation.com

## **Application Process:**

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form, (if handwritten, please print legibly.) A current copy of your State Drivers License, State ID, U.S. Passport or U.S. Military ID must be submitted with the application.
- 2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about yourself, goals, and your college plans: (college/university, intended major, and anticipated start date). Letter should not exceed five (5) pages.
- 3. Four (4) letters of recommendations from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
- 4. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average and a class standing/rank. Application must have at least a 3.0 grade point average (a "B" average.) Certified copy of transcript required.)
- 5. Personal essay must be at least four (4) typed pages, double-spaced, 12 pt / Time New Roman font. Essay shall be absent of grammatical errors. (*The essay should include a discussion of how the recipient intends to give back to the community involving children, elderly, and the disabled, how has attending college impacted your life, how will attending college impacted your life)*
- 6. Applicants should have completed at least 80+ hours of community service. Community service hours must be documented in the form of a letter of recommendation. On the letter head of organization. Applications required to submit a \$40 if they **do not** have community service as required.
- 7. Additional Financial Documentation will be required.
- 8. Family Members of the W.S.W. Foundation or Board Members are not permitted to participated in the scholarship or honorarium programs.

## **Application Renewal Process:**

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Applicants must be a prior recipient of the W.S.W. F. Scholarship Fund Program. A current copy of your State Drivers License, State ID, U.S. Passport or U.S. Military ID must be submitted with the updated application.
- 2. Applicants must be currently enrolled in a two-year (2) to a four-year (4) educational institution. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about yourself and your college plans (college/university, intended major, and anticipated start date). Letter should not exceed five (5) pages.
- 3. Applicants must have at least a 3.0 grade point average (a "B" average, Certified copy of transcript required.)
- 4. Applicants should have completed at least an additional 80+ hours of community service. Community service hours must be documented in the form of a letter of recommendation. On the letter head of organization. Applicants required to submit a \$40 "Application Fee" if they **do not** have community services as required.
- 5. Personal Essay. Essay must be at least four (4) typed pages, double-spaced, 12 pt / Time New Roman font. Essay shall contain no grammatical errors. (*The essay should include a discussion of how the recipient intends to give back to the community involving children, elderly, and the disabled, how has attending college impacted your life, how will attending college impacted your life)*
- 6. Additional Financial Documentation will be required.
- 7. Family Members of the W.S.W. Foundation or Board Members are not permitted to participated in the scholarship or honorarium programs.
